Objectives:

1. Students will describe the profession of physical therapy including the types of patients they see, the types of interventions they provide, and where they work.
2. Students will describe the term disability and will describe the components of key models of Disablement including the Nagi model, the ICF, and the social model.
3. Students will recognize the relationship between disability and the practice of physical therapy.
4. Students will describe the role of the built environment in the experience of disability using a case study example, and a home accessibility assessment form.
5. Students will complete a homework assignment where they perform a home accessibility assessment on their own home, and reflect on how they might experience disability if they had a serious disease or injury.
